Covering approximately 630 hectares, the site is strategically positioned within an area that will play a central role in Shetland's transition from fossil fuels to clean energy technologies, as our community works towards Net Zero targets. By focusing energy developments in and around this existing industrial hub, the project aims to minimise the impact of the transition on other parts of the Isles, making it a strategic and desirable choice for Shetland's future.
